

TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND RULES

TO PARTICIPATE

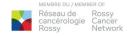
- To be eligible to play, a player must be at least 18 years of age as of October 21, 2020.
- Only eligible players will be listed on the game sheet at the time of play. Modifications can be made 30 minutes before the start of the first game.
- In order to be eligible to play and attend the VIP Draft Party, your team must be in the top 8 in fundraising.
- Rosters
 - Rosters must not exceed 9 (nine) players plus a goalie. Rosters must be submitted seven days prior of the event.
 - Will be posted on website.
 - Roster changes allowed up to noon Saturday, October 24th

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- Three (3) games with a potential to advance to the playoffs.
- All games will consist of:
 - Two minutes warm up per game
 - Two Periods of 12 minutes (running time)
 - Last minute of the 2nd period, stop time if the game is of 3 goal differential or less
 - Stop time for serious injuries only.
- Overtime: In Round Robin play, there won't be any overtime or shootout period. The Game ends as a tie.









- Mercy Rule: Mercy Rule should apply only if a game is of 8 goal difference in the 2nd period.
- Tie Breaker Rule:
 - 1. Points
 - 2. More Wins
 - 3. Less Losses
 - 4. Head to Head
 - 5. Plus/Minus (Goal Differential)
 - 6. More Goals for
 - 7. Less Goals Against
- **Point System:**
 - Regulation Win: 2 points
 - Regulation Tie: 1 Point
 - Regulation Loss: 0 points
- Discipline point (Franc-Jeu/Clean Play Point):
 - If a team commits three (3) penalties or less, team will be rewarded 1 extra discipline point in the standings.
 - If a team commits four (4) penalties or more, team will not be rewarded any discipline point.
- **Playoff Rounds:**
 - One game elimination
 - 3 on 3 five-minute sudden death overtime (If needed)
 - Three-man shootout after overtime period (If needed)
- If shootouts need to be taken, teams need to select three players from each team with no repeating shooters until everyone on the team has gone.
- Standard non-contact rules apply.









- For a 3 vs 3 play, no icing is called. Floating blue line rule should apply (This means that the initial off-side is the blue line, once the blue line is established the zone is then extended to the red line).
- All captains must sign the game sheet prior to start of each game.
- Any fighting defined as one punch thrown will result in an immediate and automatic tournament ejection.
- Any player receiving 3 penalties will result in immediate and automatic game ejection. Tournament organizers reserve right to determine any additional or subsequent discipline.
- Persistent lack of control exhibited by a team will result in ejection of the team from the tournament.
- If a slap shot is taken (defined as the stick above the horizontal in the wind-up), the play will be whistled down, and a face-off will be taken to the nearest neutral zone dot.
- Every minor penalty results in a penalty shot being awarded to the other team. Any major penalty results in the offending player being ejected from the game, and two penalty shots being awarded.
- Anything not covered in the above, Hockey Canada rules will apply.
- Organizers reserve the right to assign individual players to teams, as appropriate, and increase or reduce the number of teams at their sole discretion.
- All tournament rules and regulations are subject to change, and any decisions made by organizers are final. Other conditions may apply.
